2010 COMPETITION RULES YOUTH CUP AND PLATE FOR GIRLS & BOYS

Football Federation Tasmania will be offering a Knockout Competition in each of the following age groups

- Girls – Under 13, Under 14, Under 16
- Boys – Under 13, Under 14, Under 15, Under 16

These competitions will comprise the 2010 Youth Cup.

The Football Federation Tasmania Competition Rules shall apply to all Youth Cup games. Where there is any inconsistency between the Competition Rules and the Youth Cup Rules, the Cup Rules shall apply.

Eligibility to Enter a Youth Cup Competition

Participation in each competition is open to teams from Football Federation Tasmania clubs competing in FFT competitions.

Losers from the round of 16 will be entered into the Youth Plate. Matches in this competition will run in parallel with the Youth Cup.

Matches

The schedule of matches within each competition shall be determined by a random draw.

All matches will be played at a date and time to be advised by Football Federation Tasmania. Teams will provide team sheets for each match.

All games will be normal duration as per the FFT competition Rules.

When scores are equal at the end of NORMAL time, the match will be decided by the taking of kicks from the penalty mark as per the FIFA Rules and Regulations.

Match Balls

The Home Team (i.e. the Team listed first on the draw) is to supply two (2) match balls on the day.

Referees

Football Federation Tasmania will endeavour to supply referees for all matches at no cost to the clubs. However teams should be aware that they may be asked to provide Assistant Referees on the day.

Player Eligibility

All players must be registered players with Football Federation Tasmania.

Players may only play for a team entered by their registered Club.

Players may only play for ONE (1) team entered by their registered Club.

All players within a team shall be subject to the Football Federation Tasmania Player Age Policy.

Cautions, Expulsions and Suspensions

Any yellow cards that are received in the Knockout Cups will NOT carry over into the League competitions. Suspensions imposed for red card offences WILL carry over into the League competitions.

Code of Conduct

All Clubs, players and Team Officials must adhere to the Football Federation Australia Code of Conduct as adopted by Football Federation Tasmania

Amendment of Rules

Football Federation Tasmania reserves the right to alter or amend these rules from time to time as deemed expedient.
